











# Planning workshop for establishing a Regional Training Center on Forest Genetic Resources

#### 1-3 December, 2015, Binzhou City, Shandong Province, China

Although forest genetic resources in many Asian countries have been severely depleted, there is limited recognition about their ecological and societal importance, including for timber production and adaptation to and mitigation of climate change. Political and institutional support for conserving the resource base have not kept pace with the economic development in the region. Conservation and enhancing the sustainable use of FGR are restricted by inadequate funding and limited institutional and human capacities.

As a follow up to the State of the World's Forest Genetic Resources process, member countries of the Asia Pacific Forest genetic Resources Programme (APFORGEN) agreed in 2014 to strive towards establishing a Regional Training Centre on Forest Genetic Resources. This goal was included in APFORGEN's regional strategy for 2014-2016, the overarching aim of which is to support the implementation of the Global Plan of Action for Forest Genetic Resources in the Asia-Pacific region. The initiative is spearheaded by the Chinese Academy of Forestry which represents China in APFORGEN.

The workshop will be hosted by China Happy Ecology, a private company working on tree breeding and ecological restoration that has expressed interest to fund regular training courses on forest genetic resources under the prospective training centre.
